Notice under National Electricity Rule 4A.C.5 that Ministerial reliability gap is not forecast to occur

Terms used in this notice have the same meanings as defined in the National Electricity Law (NEL) and National Electricity Rules (NER).

On 6 January 2022, the South Australia Minister for Energy and Mining triggered an RRO in South Australia for the first quarter of 2025 by making a T-3 reliability instrument (Relevant Instrument) under then Part 7A 19B (1) (now section 14JA) of the NEL.

AEMO hereby notifies the AER under clause 4A.C.5 of the NER that the reliability forecast in the Electricity Statement of Opportunities published on 31 August 2023 shows that the forecast reliability gap (being the Ministerial reliability gap which resulted in the making of the Relevant Instrument) is not forecast to occur.

In accordance with clause 4A.C.5 of the NER, this notice will be published on AEMO's website.
