We are writing again concerning Transgrid's release of their new preferred draft route for the VNI West (NSW) link to Dinawan.

There are many flaws in this preferred route and needs more time to select a preferred route. It has been hurriedly prepared and pushed through a consulting process and hasn't taken into regard property owners agreed proposals.

The release of the document needs to be stopped before legal challenges and investigation occurs.

Routes with little or nil constraints have been dismissed and proper consideration has not been given to them.

A preferred route chosen has many constraints and Transgrid ignored its many reasons, themes and key issues including the 'precautionary rule' when dealing with 'endangered Flora and Fauna' through Windouran Pastoral Coy. Pty Ltd.
