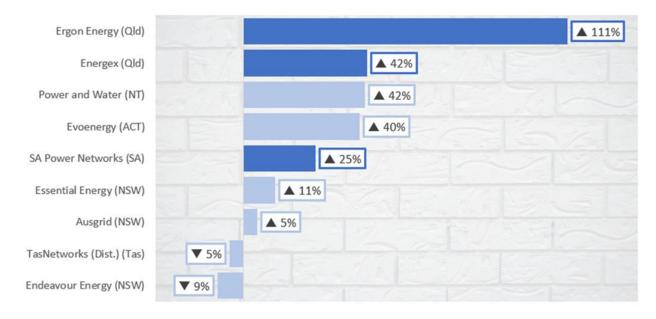

- Seek to maintain and improve asset utilisation



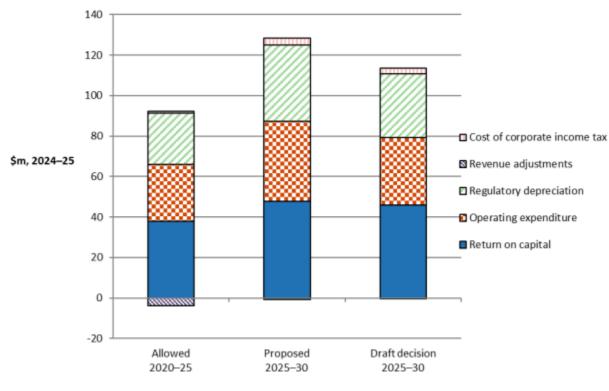

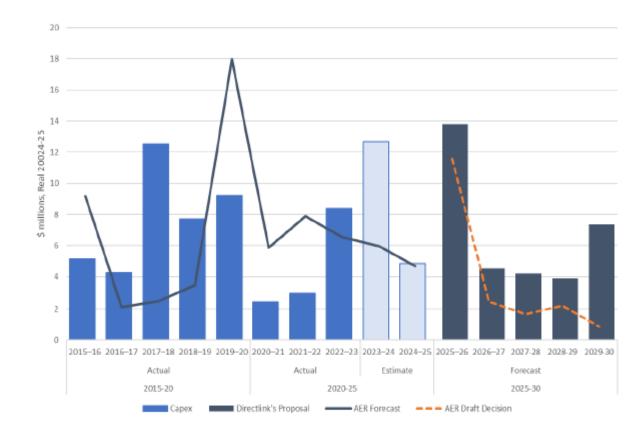
Total revenue by building block components (\$m 2024-25)

Regulatory depreciation (\$nominal)	\$34.5M (\$6.4M / 15.7% ↓ than proposed)
Operating expenditure	\$36.5M
(\$nominal)	(\$6.2M / 14.5% ↓ than proposed)

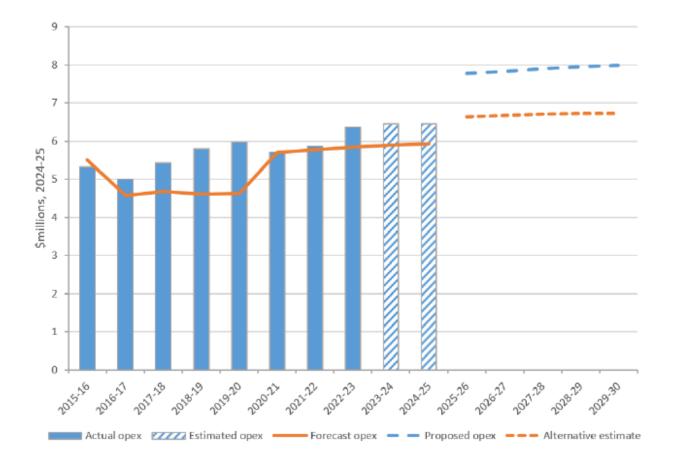

Opex forecast (\$2024–25) (Not Accepted)	\$39.4M	\$33.5M (\$5.9M / 15.0% ↓ than proposed)
Reasons for lower Opex estimate (\$2024–25) in Draft decision		
→ Removal of proposed provision for end-of-life costs	\$10.0M	\$ 5.3 M (\$4.7M / 11.9% ↓ than proposed)
→ Removal of proposed apprenticeship program step change	\$0.9M	\$ 0.0 M (\$0.9M / 2.2% ↓ than proposed)
→ Inclusion of a productivity growth factor	\$0.0M	-\$ 0.5 M (\$0.5M / 1.2% ↓ than proposed)

AER publishes draft determination decision	27 September 2024

Directlink submits revised regulatory proposal to AER	2 December 2024
Submissions on revised regulatory proposal and draft decision close	17 January 2025
AER publishes transmission determination for regulatory control period	30 April 2025
