## **RE: Network Limits dataset**

Following our recent discussion and exchange of advice related to the Victorian network limits dataset, AEMO's Victorian Planning team have now reviewed the final spreadsheet provided by AusNet Services.

AEMO confirms that the dataset has been assessed, and that the joint planning outcome indicated for each network element is appropriate. We acknowledge that AusNet Services have not proposed any specific NCIPAP projects at this time, but that several limitations have been identified which may carry economic merits in the 2022-2027 period. AEMO supports the shortlisted items as worthy of further investigation.

AEMO looks forward to working with AusNet Services to assist with any study, refinement or endorsement required for future NCIPAP projects arising from this dataset, or from other joint planning processes.
