### The Forum

The ACCC invites interested parties to attend a consultative forum on its *Draft Greenfields Guideline for Natural Gas Transmission Pipelines*, released on 25 June 2002.

#### What is the Greenfields Guideline?

The Greenfields Guideline has been developed to assist prospective pipeline developers, investors, financiers, consultants and users in the gas industry understand the regulation of new natural gas (greenfields) transmission pipelines. The ACCC recognises there are unique characteristics associated with developing new gas pipelines. Accordingly the Greenfields Guideline will:

- facilitate improved understanding of the regulatory framework and the circumstances in which it applies;
- demonstrate the flexibility and options available within the existing regulatory framework for prospective investors to tailor an access regime that recognises their unique circumstances; and
- provide certainty in relation to the regulatory treatment of key issues.

# **Purpose of the Forum**

The forum will provide an opportunity for an open, constructive and informative discussion of the options available within the existing regulatory framework that can accommodate the unique issues associated with new or prospective natural gas transmission pipelines.

The forum is designed to allow further consultation with industry and other interested parties prior to the ACCC finalising the *Greenfields Guideline*.

Forum participants will be invited to discuss the Greenfields Guideline and pose questions to the panel - comprising ACCC staff and consultants.
