SACOSS is of the view that the Framework and Approach (F&A) for SA Power Networks **does need** to be revisited for the coming 2015-20 regulatory period.

We are of the view that sufficient progress in energy market reform has, or will, occur to justify a review. These reforms include the AER's Better Regulation Program, the introduction of the Regulatory Investment Test for Distribution and the recommendations of the AEMC's Power of Choice Review.
