Re: Draft Instrument: Retailer Austhorisation Guideline

Thank you for the opportunity to provide further comment on the Australian Energy Regulator (AER)'s *Retailer Authorisation Guideline* (Draft Instrument), in addition to our previous submissions dated 27 April 2010 (AER's Issue Paper) and 22 December 2010 (AER's Draft Guideline).

As stated in our previous comments, EWOV supports the AER's approach for providing energy retailer authorisations, and for the transfer, surrender or revocation of retailer authorisations.

Additionally, EWOV agrees with the AER's suggested approach for entry criteria and the transfer, surrender and revocation of a retailer authorisation. EWOV specifically welcomes the inclusion of a requirement for former retailers to maintain membership of an ombudsman scheme for 12 months after the surrender of its authorisation.
