

STATUTORY DECLARATION

Oaths Act 1900, NSW, Ninth Schedule

I, [REDACTED] of [REDACTED], do hereby solemnly declare and affirm that:

1. I am an officer, for the purposes of the *NATIONAL ELECTRICITY (NEW SOUTH WALES) LAW* (NEL), of NSW Electricity Networks Operations Pty Ltd as a Trustee for the NSW Electricity Networks Operations Trust (ABN 70 250 995 390) (TransGrid), a regulated network service provider for the purposes of section 28D of the NEL.  - (a) provided *forecast information* which is TransGrid's best forecast of the information in accordance with the requirements of the Notice.

And I make this solemn declaration, as to the matters aforesaid, according to the law in this behalf made – and subject to the punishment by law provided for any wilfully false statement in any such declaration.
